- Why can't you put it in Sydney?
- Why not by railway?
- The decision is a foregone conclusion - why are we having this meeting?
- Traditional landowners
- Have you read the report from plant in Austria/Germany?
- Health risks - proposing to take control of processing of red top bins - submission to Efw policy - SP pushed back on batteries etc going into
 - a) take responsibility for processing
- SP asking the EPA to lower the standards
- Will you take waste from Mardian? Or Kemps Creek waste? Via Tarago? Anything off Veolia?
- Is the substation on your property?
- Will you get special permission for Native vegetation clearance?
- All the trucks running with GPS? All the information available to the public?

- Compensation for wool contamination from emissions for loss of my organic status?
- If I test my wool fibre before the plant starts - baseline data - if after there is evidence, will there be compensation?
- Now about power, it's about waste management - \$600M gas-fired station → we don't need the power. It's not Ferrara Power, it's Ferrara Waste Incinerator. It is a waste treatment plant, it's not about power generation. We're against waste treatment plant here.
- How many trucks per day?
- The ambulance - will that be based at Mandan? Why?
 - no ambulance station in Mandan
- Bottom ash - what % of waste going in comes out as bottom ash?
- Who will the process the waste between Council contractor picking it up and it coming to Ferrara facility?
 - Will it be Clearaway?
- What's your estimate of heavy metals + batteries that will be processed?
- Why can't it be put in a higher ^{density} residential area like Sydney?
 - \$ for purchasing land in Sydney will be offset by transport Savings

- Why could you build this in Sydney on an existing landfill site?
- Why was Eastern Creek knocked back?
- If it's safe why not put it at Parliament House?
- If it is safe, is it only water steam + CO₂?
- So is the shutdown instantaneous?
- How high is the stack going to be? Why does the stack have to be 60-90m high?
- Where does the water come from?
- Where does the water go?
- Have you purchased the land already?
- Isn't CO₂ hazardous to human health? Animal health - wildlife?
- 24/7 monitoring by the ~~EPA~~ EPA - how will that work? And do they have SLAs on you with response times? How they can shut you down if there is an alarm?
- air monitoring 24/7 by EPA doesn't give us a huge amount of confidence
- Lack of confidence in EPA in Bulgaria
- Water for many of us is a major concern - worry is that you'll use bores
- Have you spoken ^{to} Angus Taylor and what is his position?

• If the community is overwhelmingly opposed to this throughout the process, can that influence whether this project goes ahead?

• What is the volume of the water required at the site?

• If there is a really heavy rainfall on the site

• PFC in the waste stream - what happens to PVC pipe when it's burnt?

• Why can't you put the CO₂ in the ground?

• Would JP be advised to be conform to the EFW policy statement? - Must understand that you must get community agreement

• If the proposal doesn't go through what happens to the land?

• Security of site - automation of site + monitoring of emissions - how do you secure your power - ensure no power shortage that impacts automation + monitoring?

• Site access security?

• Submission requests that EPA doesn't make 100% compliance requirements - normal operational conditions

• Hope the technology is not Chinese

• Watercourse runs through middle of the plant

• How does this affect farmer/producer organic certification?

• Do you get compensation for losing that organic status?

• This technology is used in a lot of cold countries - cold temperatures, dark winters to heat a lot of homes + they have a lot of water

Inputs like water + waste

It's a different setting here in Bulgaria

• Who pays who when lifestyles are ruined?

• Are you going to notify all the people where this power line is going to go? How long until you have that information?

• Who is the consent authority?

• What would stop them from approving this proposal?
